Stay in Your Lane

What does "staying in your lane mean?" For me, it means not asserting myself in others business, not taking on others drama, not making someone else's "stuff, my stuff." Essentially, "*If it's not my load to carry, I'm setting it down.*" Easier said than done, especially in a career that requires me to have my finger on the pulse of everything. During lent we are carving 5 minutes out of our day for reflection and prayer. We are taking the time to log off, shut down, and pray in silence.

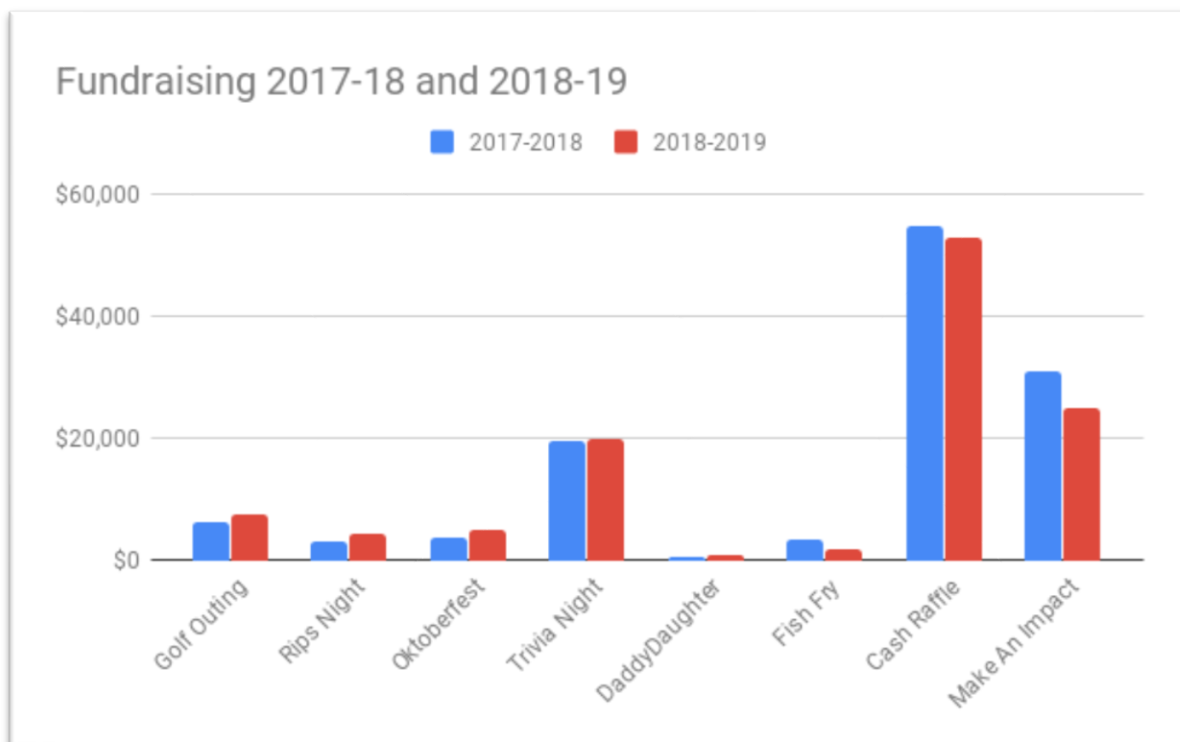
