

## BEFORE AND AFTER CARE 2021-2022

1. **PROCEDURE- Before Care:** Before Care begins at 7:10. Students will enter through the front doors of the halle. Parents of younger children may walk them to the door, but we ask that parents do not enter the building. We ask that each student uses hand sanitizer as he/she enters the building. Masks will be required by all students. Students will be required to remain socially distanced.
2. **PROCEDURE- After Care:** After school ends, students will walk with their teacher over to the church halle. Students will be required to wear masks while at aftercare. It might be necessary for parents to make sure that their child has one or more extra masks aside from what is sent for the regular school day. Snacks will not be provided by the teachers. However, parents may send a prepackaged snack for their child to eat at aftercare. Students will be required to remain socially distanced while at aftercare. Siblings will be allowed to sit together. Parents will need to pick up at the front doors of the halle. Note that this is different from past years. Parents may enter the first set of double doors, but should remain in the entryway while the teacher on duty helps your child collect his/her belongings and meet you there.
3. **"BUSY BOX" - Before and After Care:** Since we will not be able to have the students share toys as we had in the past, we are asking for each child to bring a "busy box". The "busy box" should be about the size of a plastic pencil box/case. We will have coloring sheets available, so crayons, colored pencils, or markers might be one thing a student would put into his/her "busy box". Students may bring other small toys/games to play with while at aftercare. We have decided that handheld electronic devices will be acceptable toys for the "busy box". Keep in mind that any toys/devices brought for before/aftercare must be kept in the student's backpack for the duration of the school day. "Busy boxes" will not be kept at school overnight. Each student will take his/her box home at the end of each day. Older students will be able to work on homework as needed at before or aftercare. All students must bring their own pens and pencils.
